 The imposing frescoed loggia welcomes you to the new museum in the town of Abano Terme. The 16th-century villa contains beautiful frescos painted according to the tastes of the late 1500s and early 1600s depicting famous historical and mythological episodes. After a long wait and a lot of work, the villa now houses a large collection of furnishings, objects, engravings, drawings and paintings from the fifteenth to the twentieth century. It is a museum-home whose historical and artistic route takes the visitor along the taste and culture of the nineteenth century. Artists include Palma il Giovane, Pietro and Alessandro Longhi, Gian Domenico Tiepolo, Moretto da Brescia, Giovan Battista Moroni and Alessandro Magasco. Particular highlights of the works on display include the charming portrait of Eleonora Talone by Cesare Tallone and the portrait of Isabella Nowak by the Bergamo artist Rinaldo Agazzi. Nowak was the mother of Roberto Bassi Rathgeb who continues to welcome visitors to his collection to this day.

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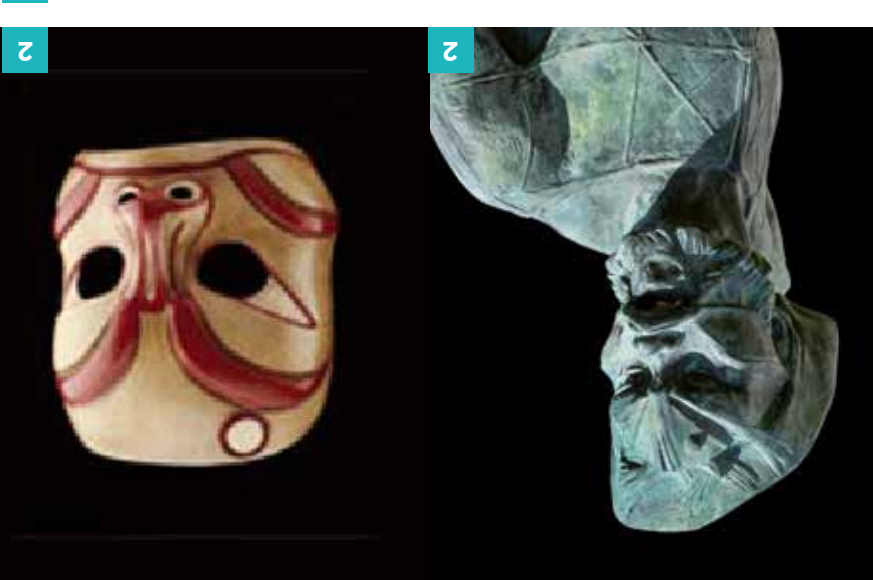

4 MUSEO D'ARTE CONTEMPORANEA DINO FORMAGGIO TEOLO

The museum was opened to the public in October 1993 and is housed in Palazzetto dei Vicari, previously the administrative and military headquarters of the Venetian Serenissima Republic, dating back to the end of the 16th century. It was named after Dino Formaggio not only because of his renown as a philosopher and art critic, but also due to all his generous donations of works of art and sculpture that make up the museum collection. In keeping with Formaggio's phenomenological philosophy of art, of which he was a staunch supporter in Italy, the singular museum collection numbers two hundred works by 86 artists who represent the remarkable technical and cultural artistic revolutions of the last century.

5 CASTELLO DI SAN PELAGIO MUSEO DEL VOLO PARCO DELLE ROSE E DEI LABIRINTI DUE CARRARE

The *Castle of San Pelagio* is of medieval origins. On 9th August 1918, the poet Gabriele d'Annunzio left for an unusual flight over Vienna where he made his famous feat: he launched thousands of leaflets on the skies of the Austro-Hungarian capital. In the rooms of the Poet everything has remained as it was back then in order for you to relive those moments and retrace the history of human flight in one of Europe's unique museums.

6 CASTELLO DEL CATAJO LA REGGIA DEI COLLI EUGANEI BATTAGLIA TERME

Considered the palace of the Euganean Hills, the Catajo Castle is one of the largest and most surprising Italian historical residences. Its bizarre architecture dates back to 1570, when the cycle of frescoes on the 'piano nobile' halls was also realized: pictorial work by Giovanni Battista Zelotti represents a unique case in the Venetian Renaissance history and today is still visible in perfect conservation state. The park is rich in centuries-old trees.

The garden received many awards and it is considered one of the most important in Europe: an unforgettable walk in history among sculptures, fountains, century old trees from all over the world and the labyrinth.

In 1369 Francesco Petrarca (Arezzo 1304 – Arquà 1374) had one of the houses in the Euganean village of Arquà adapted to his requirements, and elected to live in it for the rest of his days. Here he was surrounded by old and new friends and by the members of his family: his daughter Francesca, his son-in-law Francescuolo da Bassano, and his grand-daughter Eletta.

10 MUSEO NAZIONALE ATESTINO ESTE

The National Museum of Este illustrates the civilization of the ancient Venetians, which characterized the social and cultural development of the territory during the first millennium BC, in a dynamic relationship with the Etruscan, Celtic and Roman world. It preserves in its rooms archaeological materials of prestige and considerable beauty.

11 COMPLESSO MONUMENTALE DI MONSELICE

Built between the 11th and 16th century, the imposing Castello Cini houses a complex of buildings and recreates a medieval and Renaissance atmosphere. The centuries-old dwelling is recalled in the Romanesque house with chatelet, today fitted out with rustic furniture. The tyrant Ezzelino added an imposing defensive tower with chimneys that were unique in Italy in terms of form and function. With the advent of the Venetian Serenissima Republic, the complex was acquired by the Venetian family, who added a precious library and a private chapel; they restructured the courtyard, creating a pleasant and reserved space for concerts and theatre performances. The complex was used constantly until the nineteenth century as a magnificent summer home.

The Palazzo della Ragione was built in 1218-19 and it was the seat of the courts of justice until the end of the 18th century. On the first floor there is one of the largest medieval hanging hall in the world, called "il Salone", and on the walls there are frescoes with astrological subjects, inspired by the theories by Pietro d'Abano professor of medicine and natural philosophy (1250-1318).

The centrally located Piazza Eremitani contains the City Museums, the Archaeological Museum with pre-Roman, Roman, Etruscan, Greek and Italic materials, and Egyptian collections, and the Museum of Medieval and Modern Art with collections of Venetian painting from the 14th to the 16th centuries and a collection of sculptures. The Museums are housed in the cloisters of the old monastery of the Eremitani monks.

The impressive collection of objects and fabrics from the 1500s to the 1800s fills the architectural space of the ancient Ashkenazi-German Synagogue, a testimony to the significant presence of the Jewish community in Padua from the age of the Cararesi. The exquisite mid-sixteenth-century Italian Synagogue should not be missed. The old Jewish cemeteries: you should definitely visit at least one of them. Created from 1527 onwards, they contain headstones dating back to subsequent centuries and hold the remains of internationally-renowned scholars, Talmudists and cabalists.

In the adjacent rooms are precious furnishings coming from the canonical sacristy of the cathedral.
